

Alexander Fund Grants: Promoting Sexual Health

In 2001 The Alexander Fund, now part of the Franklin Alumni Association & Foundation, was created in memory of Paul James Alexander, class of 1945. He was a physician who devoted much of his career to fostering medical care in underdeveloped countries. In May 1986 he was slain in Haiti by a housebreaker. His assailant was never identified.

Grants funded by the Alexander Fund must be in keeping with the Surgeon General's Call to Action To Promote Sexual Health and Responsible Behavior (June 2001):

Promote among students the sense of individual responsibility, namely –

- Providing a realistic and accurate sexuality education curriculum to help the students acquire the ability to understand and weigh the risks, responsibilities, outcomes and impacts of sexual actions
- An understanding and awareness of one's sexuality and sexual development
- Respect for oneself and one's partner
- Avoidance of physical or emotional harm to either oneself or one's partner
- Ensuring that pregnancy occurs only when welcome
- Recognition and tolerance of the diversity of sexual values within any community

Strengthening the understanding that sexual health includes freedom from sexual abuse and discrimination and the ability of individuals to integrate their sexuality into their lives, derive pleasure from it, and to reproduce if they so choose.

The fund now has accrued interest of \$2000 which is available for grants.
